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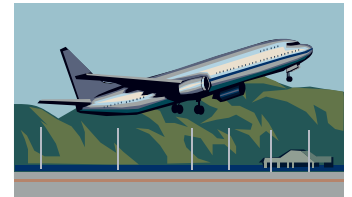
Hello WSOSC Members,

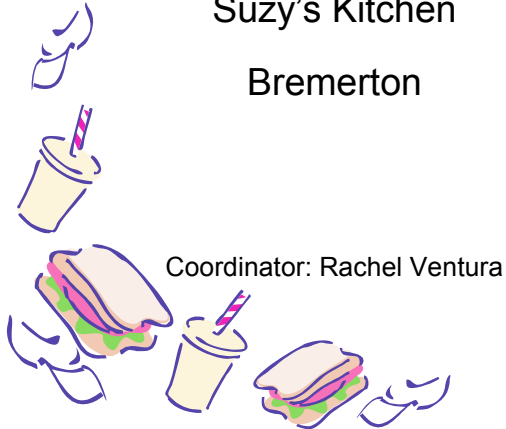

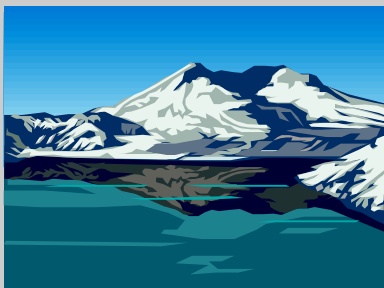

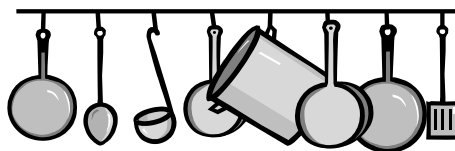

## COOK'S CORNER



### Curry Chicken Salad

From the Kitchen of  
Linda Power

4 cans chicken chunks (or leftover chicken, shredded)  
1 red onion chopped  
1/2 cup golden raisins  
1/2 cup chopped celery  
1/4 cup pine nuts  
2 Tbls curry powder  
4 Tbls mayonnaise  
Endive leaves

Combine all ingredients except endive leaves, and taste. Salt and pepper to taste.

Serve on endive leaves.

You can add any ingredients you love. For example, bell peppers, cranberries, and/or any type of nuts can substitute any or all of the ingredients above.
